CRITICAL CARE STATION: RESUSCITATION

- BLS and ALS in pregnant lady
- Brady, Tachyarrhythmias Defibrillator hands on use
- Crash Cart set up, commonly used drugs and dilutions Atropine,
 Adrenaline, Magnesium, Bicarb, Furosemide, Calcium, Potassium,
 Amiodarone
- Primary survey / management of trauma in pregnancy

CRITICAL CARE STATION: OXYGEN THERAPY, AIRWAY AND VENTILATION

- Oxygen delivery devices
- Bag valve mask ventilation and use of airway adjuncts
- NIV and HFNC
- Intubation preparedness, airway management and challenges
- FONA Front Of Neck Airway when, where and how to do?

CRITICAL CARE STATION: HAEMORRHAGIC SHOCK - CRITICAL CARE MANAGEMENT
