On behalf of the Royal Care Super Speciality Hospital, I welcome you all for the 4th "RCH ICU UPDATE"

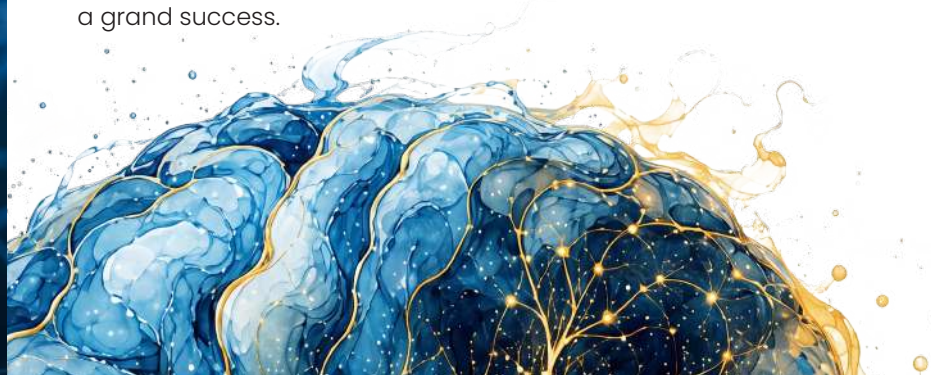
The theme for this year CME will be "NEURO CRITICAL CARE"
